Our Core Startup Program

Our core Startup Program provides inclusive financing, mentorship and other resources to support diverse young entrepreneurs from planning to launch and growth:

- Up to 15-20 hours of **pre-launch support**
- Up to \$60,000 in collateral-free, startup and inclusive loan **financing** (includes 2:1 matched financing from BDC*)
- Up to **two years of one-to-one mentoring** and support from volunteer mentors
- **Resources and events** that expand and enhance business knowledge
- Resources and networks to **support growth**

Indigenous Entrepreneur Startup Program

Futurpreneur proudly manages and delivers a tailored version of our Startup Program for young Indigenous entrepreneurs aged 18-39 in First Nations, Métis and Inuit communities and urban centres across the country.

Indigenous Startup Program includes:

- **Inclusive startup financing** from \$5,000 to \$60,000*
- Two years of 1-1 expert **mentorship**
- **Access to the resources** including an Indigenous-specific version of our Business Plan Writer and Cash Flow Template
- **Networking opportunities** to engage with a national network of Indigenous entrepreneurs, leaders and Indigenous-led community organizations
- **Coaching and support** from our dedicated team with lived experience



Black Entrepreneur Startup Program

Futurpreneur, with funding from RBC is proudly managing and delivering a tailored version of our Startup Program for young Black entrepreneurs aged 18-39 over the next five+ years.

Black Entrepreneur Startup Program includes:

- **Inclusive startup financing** from \$5,000 to \$60,000*
- Two years of 1-1 expert **mentorship**
- **Access to the resources** including our interactive Business Plan Writer and Cash Flow Template
- **Networking opportunities** to engage with a national network of Black entrepreneurs, leaders and Black-led community organizations
- Opportunity for up to **\$40,000 in follow-on financing**, funded by RBC, based on the first two years of successful business performance
- **Coaching and support** from our dedicated team with lived experience

*Up to \$40,000 of which is delivered by Futurpreneur, funded by RBC, and up to \$20,000 loaned by BDC
